FIRE SPRINKLER SYSTEM PROCEDURE

DIESEL PUMP

- 1. Check fuel level Additional diesel fuel is in a yellow 20 litre container inside the shed.
- 2. Ensure that the main outlet (Red 1) diesel pump inlet (Red 2), domestic water pump inlet (Red 3) and domestic water (Red 4) valves are OPEN.
- 3. Ensure that the diesel to domestic water valve (Red 5) is CLOSED.
- 4. Electric start Start the diesel with the key switch (Red 6)
- 5. **Manual start** Operate the red de-compression lever behind the cylinder block. Pull the starting cord. Repeat the de-compression lever and pull cord operation until the diesel starts.
- 6. The diesel will run up to a pre-set speed. Speed adjustment lever is (Red 7)
- 7. Confirm that the yard, house, shed and cattery fire sprinklers are operational.
- 8. Check the diesel (engine speed and pump leaks) every half hour of operation.

DIESEL PUMP to DOMESTIC WATER SUPPLY

- 1. CLOSE the Domestic valve (Red 4)
- 2. OPEN the diesel to domestic valve (Red 6) SLOWLY
- 3. Monitor the pressure gauge. Pressure should be approx. 50 PSI and no more than 70 PSI.
